- Reports test findings in technical reports in a timely manner
- Uses computer assisted software and equipment to prepare documents
- Communicates with building owners and contractors.
- Checks contract documents to ensure accurate test results.
- Collects data, defines problems, evaluates facts, and draws valid conclusions.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS: Minimal High School diploma or equivalent. Associates or Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering Technology or similar field preferred and/or related experience. Minimum of 1 - 5+ years of experience in various construction fields such as steel, concrete, soils, roofing, building envelope, and masonry. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to effectively communicate with managers, clients, and office personnel. Must be able to observe and document job activities and write reports.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit; stand; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls, reach with hands and arms, and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to walk, sit, climb or balance, and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Must be capable and willing to perform in-house lab testing and observe job activities on the job site. Must have reliable transportation. Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills necessary.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS: Must have valid drivers license. OSHA certification a plus. Will be required to pass a CORI check.
